Recommended for adoption.

GENERAL COMMENTS ON THE DOCUMENT

- The PPWG was established under the CMS Scientific Council, which was appropriate at the time as the task was to review the scale of the problem and develop guidelines. Now that the PPWG has moved into the operational phase, it is recommended to consider giving it the same status as the Energy Task Force and Illegal Killing Task Force i.e. reporting direct to COP rather than to the Scientific Council.
- Similarly, the Lead Task Force, which is under the PPWG, would require some amendments to its Terms of Reference to align with the different status of the PPWG.
