## **DRAFT PROGRAMME OF WORK 2018-2020**

(Prepared by the CMS Secretariat)

- Since its adoption by the Eleventh Meeting of the Conference of the Parties (COP11) in 2014, the Programme of Work (POW) for 2015-2017 has proven to be an important tool guiding the work of the Secretariat and allowing for more streamlined annual reporting on progress on implementation.
- 2. On the basis of the experience gained over the last triennium, the Secretariat has proposed slight adjustments to the template which has been used for developing the POW 2018-2020 for the Secretariat.
- 3. The current POW contains all mandates falling under the responsibility of the Secretariat as well as those that fall under the Standing Committee and Scientific Council and their Working Groups that require the Secretariat's support.
- 4. These mandates relate to existing instruments being all CMS Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) including those serviced by dedicated personnel, such as those on Dugongs, Birds of Prey, Sharks and IOSEA, as well as Action Plans; Programmes of Work; Initiatives; Concerted Actions and provisions of Resolutions and Decisions (i.e. new ones and those partly repealed, consolidated or retained in full) to be adopted by COP12.
- 5. These mandates have been translated into activities which may require human and/or financial resources over the triennium. An indication has been given as to whether resources are available or to be sought.
- 6. For each activity, the funding source has been indicated as funds provided through the Budget 2018-2020 as proposed in UNEP/CMS/COP12/Doc.14.2 being Trust Fund and/ or through voluntary contribution. Where no funding source has been indicated (blanks) it means that the activity can be carried out by staff at the Secretariat. Indicative staffing for each programme area, as per UNEP/CMS/COP12/Doc.14.2, is also included.
- 7. The detailed list of activities is grouped into programme areas as follows:
  - Executive Direction and Management;
  - Implementation Support;
  - Resource Mobilization and Interagency Affairs;
  - Information Management, Communication and Outreach;
  - Capacity-building;
  - Servicing of Governing Bodies
- 8. For each activity priority ranking has been given. Core activities are those that the Secretariat strives to implement as a matter of course. Thereafter, and as far as resources permitting, priority will be given to those activities ranked as high followed by those indicated as medium. Least attention will be given to those listed as low.
- 9. Upon adoption of the POW, a reference will be made for each activity to the Targets of the Strategic Plan Migratory Species and those related to the Sustainable Development Goals

with a view to determining and monitoring the contributions of the Secretariat to the Strategic Plan for Migratory Species 2015-2023 and the Sustainable Development Goals.

10. The Secretariat will continue to provide regular reports on the status of implementation of the POW to the Standing Committee and eventually to the COP both as comprehensive narratives highlighting achievements, challenges and next steps, and in tabular form.
