- 1. The Agenda of the Fortieth Meeting of the CMS Standing Committee (Bonn, November, 2012) included items on: Adoption of Rules of Procedure; COP Organizational Changes; COP Rules of Procedure and Retirement of Resolutions.
- 2. The Committee did not have sufficient time to examine these issues in any depth so a Working Group was established to consider them inter-sessionally.
- 3. The Members selected to serve on the Working Group were: Chile, Germany, New Zealand, Pakistan and Uganda. The terms of reference for the Working Group (see Annex III to the draft report of the 40th Meeting of the Standing Committee UNEP/CMS/StC41/4.1) allowed it to elect its own officers, and consequently New Zealand assumed the Chair.
- 4. The Working Group has produced four papers, which are reproduced in the annexes attached. Each of these annexes contains a number of recommendations and requests for action:
 - i. Conference of the Parties: Organizational Changes;
 - ii. Conference of the Parties to the Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild Animals: Rules of Procedure;
 - iii. Standing Committee of the Convention on Migratory Species: Rules of Procedure; and
 - iv. Review of Decisions (Resolutions and Recommendations).
